Notice to Customers

The Washington State Department of Agriculture imposed an Apple Maggot Quarantine in the 1980's to stop the spread of the pest to agricultural areas of the state. All of Western Washington and several Eastern Washington counties are quarantined. To prevent the spread of the apple maggot into Douglas County, the Greater Wenatchee Regional Landfill operates under state and Douglas County rules and regulations.

Our WSDA permit has the following requirements:

- A transfer station in a quarantine area must implement a plan to segregate and divert Municipal Green Waste (MGW) from the Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) being exported, or
- The exporting county or municipality in a Quarantine Area includes in its Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan a program for segregating and diverting MGW from the MSW waste stream, and.
- Importation and disposal of MSW from a Quarantine Area must be approved by the Agricultural Subcommittee of the Douglas County Technical Advisory Committee.
- We do not accept bulk green waste or municipal green waste from Quarantine Areas.
