How to use this card:

1. Take the stickers on your fruits and veggies.

2. Put the stickers on your sticker card.

# FOOD SCRAPS Meat, seafood, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers. PLaza delivery boxes, coffee grounds and filters, tea bags, waxed cardboard, soiled paper bags, kitchen paper towels, paper napkins as well as loose shredded paper.

 Don't stop! Keep taking stickers off of your fruits and veggies make arts and crafts with them or throw the stickers in the garbage.

3. Ask your family to help!
