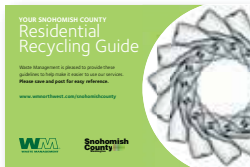


SNOHOMISH COUNTY RECYCLING RESOURCES

Moving Box Alternatives

- Rent reusable moving boxes from Frog Box frogbox.com/seattle 206-588-5463
- Use luggage to move items instead of boxes



Use reusable packing materials like newspaper or old bubble wrap to secure fragile items.

Create a reusable box exchange at your complex to share boxes with neighbors who are moving in or out.

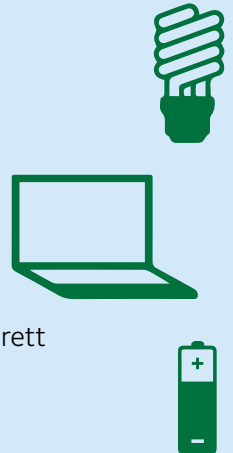
