New Recycling Program Announcement

Consider this announcement when introducing a new recycling program at your property.

Recycling Now Available!

We're pleased to announce that we are adding recycling service for residents and are launching a new building-wide recycling program.

We are counting on you to get this new program off to a good start! Recycling the paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass from your household will help reduce the amount of things thrown away as garbage and is an important and simple step to building a greener community.

Recycling container(s) are now located next to each of the building's garbage containers. Recycling containers are marked with a sticker that explains what you may place in the recycling. To make it easier for you to participate in the recycling program, you will receive the following tools and resources:
