## **RIGHT-SIZE YOUR SERVICE**

#### RECEPTACLE SIZE

Cart, container, and compactor/roll-off service is available to meet your workplace garbage and recycling needs.







32-90 gallons 1-8 cubic yards 10-40 cubic yards Each receptacle/size has weight limitations that cannot be exceeded.

 Items must fit in the receptacles with lids closed or overages may be assessed.

**CUSTOMER REQUIREMENTS**

- The space surrounding the garbage and recycling receptacles must remain unobstructed and accessible for collection.
- Only items accepted for recycling are to be placed in the recycling bins (see reverse).

**INCLEMENT WEATHER DELAYS** 

Safety is a top priority. During hazardous conditions, like ice, snow, heat, or poor air

quality, your pickup may be delayed. Your receptacles will be emptied as soon as it is

safe to do so.

## **RECEPTACLE QUANTITY**

Consider the number of enclosures, space, and volume generated.

## **COLLECTION FREQUENCY**

Weekly service is the most cost-effective. When space constraints prevent weekly service, increased frequency can help meet your disposal needs. Work with your collector to help right-size service.

### **LOCAL REQUIREMENTS**

**Recycling** is required at workplaces and multifamily communities. **Food scrap separation** is required for many food businesses. To determine if you meet the requirements and/or to request free assistance and resources, contact <a href="mailto:greenbiz@clackamas.us">greenbiz@clackamas.us</a>.

## **HAZARDOUS WASTE**



Chemicals, light bulbs, computers, TVs, sharps & other hazardous waste require proper disposal.

- Buying good-condition, secondhand items saves money and minimizes waste.
- Many materials not accepted for workplace recycling may be recycled at drop-off sites.

#### **LARGE ITEMS**



If donation is not an option, call your garbage company to pick up items too large for your garbage container (e.g., old office furniture, electronics, etc.) for an extra fee.

# **CLEANUP CONTAINERS & DUMPSTERS**



Containers are available for clean outs and construction debris. Call your garbage company to right-size the container to your project, arrange for drop off, and determine fees and restrictions specific to your project.
