## **CONTAINER SET OUT GUIDELINES**

- Recycling is collected weekly on the same day as garbage service.
- Place carts at curb the night before your service day. June 1 – September 30 service begins 5 am October 1 – May 1 service begins 6 am



 Lid opening toward street.

> At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes. Place recycling bins to the side of your trash cart so the bins are not blocking the cart.

### SERVICE ALERTS

WM is able to provide service in most weather conditions. If inclement weather conditions prevent safe collection use the My WM App or visit servicealerts.wmnorthwest.com to learn about any service delays and recovery plans.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

WM provides collection service on all holidays except Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Weekday holidays will delay collection by one day for the remainder of the week. For example: if the holiday falls on Thursday, Thursday customers will be collected on Friday and Friday customers on Saturday.

## SPECIAL SERVICE - FALL LEAF COLLECTION

Leaves are collected during the first full calendar week (M–F) of November, December, and January. Put leaves in black garbage bags and place them next to your cart on collection day. (No limit on bags; each bag must be less than 55 pounds.) **There is no extra charge for this leaf service.** 

## RECYCLING LIST

Place loose, clean recyclables into your blue recycling bin.

#### RECYCLABLES SHOULD BE CLEAN, DRY, AND EMPTY.

## Paper & Cardboard

Mail, envelopes, newspaper, flattened cardboard, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper boxes (cereal, etc.) **Cardboard must be broken down and bundled into 3'x3' pieces** 



Plastic Bottles & Jugs Plastic bottles (clean, empty and no lids)

Metal Cans Aluminum & tin cans (no sharp or greasy metal)



No Motor Oil!



When in doubt, throw it out. ONLY listed items should go in your recycle bin.

## **RECYCLING TIPS**

- Put extra recyclables in a clearly labeled kraft paper bag, cardboard box or 35-gallon container with handles and lid. Please label "Recycle."
- If you have an old "glass only" labeled recycle bin, use it for mixed recycling.
- Motor oil can be recycled at the Transfer Station.

- Always bag all garbage to prevent litter and nuisances.
- Double bag pet waste, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust and cold ashes.
- Garbage must be contained in a WM provided cart with the lid closed.

## FREE DISPOSAL PROGRAM

For those times when you have more waste than your garbage cart can handle, the City of Kennewick's Free Disposal Program is your solution. Free trips to the WM Kennewick Transfer Station!

- Must be current WM single-family residential customer within the City of Kennewick with account in good standing.
- No commercial waste accepted.
- Load limit is one level standard pickup truck load. 2.5 yards per trip. Loads over 2.5 yards will be charged standard rates.
- · Cover your load.
- Six (6) trips per calendar year (Jan Dec)

- · Non-reusable household junk
- Washers and dryers
- Water heaters
- Stoves
- Dishwashers
- Small appliances Lawn mowers Tires (limit 2)
- Furniture
- Toilets and sinks
- Mattresses (limit 1 per trip)
- Power tools
- Yard debris

- Concrete\*
- Drv wall
- Refrigerators, freezers, A/C's\*
- Roofing
- Insulation
- All flooring (tile, carpet, vinyl, and wood)

- Doors, door frames, windows Masonry
- Sidina
- Structural metal
