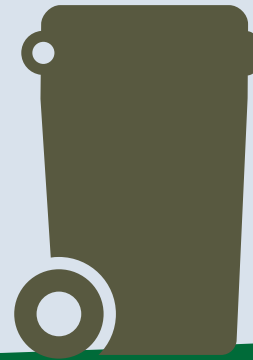

Service Information

Place garbage and recycling at the curb by 6 a.m. Place recycling bins to the side of your trash cart so the bins are not blocking the cart. Please always keep the sidewalks clear, and place containers in the street as close to the curb as possible.

LEAF COLLECTION

Waste Management collects bagged leaves during the first full calendar week (M–F) of November, first week of December, and the first week of January. Put leaves in black garbage bags and place next to your cart on collection day. (No limit on bags; each bag must be less than 55 pounds.)

There is no extra charge for this leaf service.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Waste Management provides collection service on all holidays except Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If either of these holidays fall on a weekday on or before your regular collection day that week, your scheduled collection will be the next day. For example: if the holiday falls on Thursday, Thursday customers will be collected on Friday and Friday customers on Saturday.

SERVICE DELAYS

Waste Management is able to provide service in most weather conditions. In an event of extreme inclement weather event, visit wmnorthwest.com to learn about any weather-related service delays. If weather conditions prevent safe collection, up to twice as much garbage will be collected at no extra charge on your next regular collection day. No credits will be issued for collection delays due to weather.

Paint Disposal

To dispose of water and latex based paint, please open the containers, and solidify the paint. You can use kitty litter or sawdust to speed up the drying process. Once dry, the paint can be disposed of in your household garbage cans.

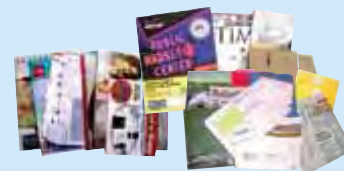

MIXED RECYCLING BIN

Paper

Mail, envelopes, newspaper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper boxes (cereal boxes, etc.)



Plastic Bottles

Plastic Bottles (empty)



Aluminum and Tin Cans

Empty and clean aluminum, steel and tin cans and containers (no lids)

PLACE NEXT TO BIN

Cardboard

Flatten all cardboard. Bundle and place next to recycling bins. No larger than 3 x 3 feet.



Motor Oil

Place used motor oil in plastic one-gallon containers that have screw on caps.



THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR EXTRA RECYCLING



If you typically have extra recyclables, you may order a free additional bin at 1-877-466-4668.

- Plastic bags
- Scrap metal or propane tanks of any size
- Foam cups, foam containers or packing material
- Plastic trays, plates, utensils
- Food or food-covered recyclables
- Toxic containers (auto products, pesticides, etc.)
- Window glass, ceramics, mirrors, fluorescent bulbs or tubes
- Liquids
