

# CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDE

Recycling is picked up every other week.  
We recommend that you wait until the cart is full to bring it to the curb.



## Mixed Recycling

All recyclables must be clean, empty and loose when they go into the cart.

## KEEP OUT of Your Recycling Container

- ✗ Plastic Bags
- ✗ Bath Tissue, Paper Towels or Coated Paper
- ✗ Plastic Lids or Straws
- ✗ Pizza Boxes or Food Soiled Cardboard
- ✗ Bags or Bottles Containing Hazardous Materials
- ✗ Hazardous Waste
- ✗ Styrofoam



## Glass Recycling – in the Bin

Put in glass bin. Mix all colors. Labels ok.

*\*Glass is not accepted at the curb on Sauvie Island.*

Bring glass to the depot on NW Charlton Rd behind Sauvie Academy.

## Motor Oil Accepted Curbside

Put in a clear plastic bottle with a screw on lid.  
Do not mix with other liquids. Place next to recycling cart.
