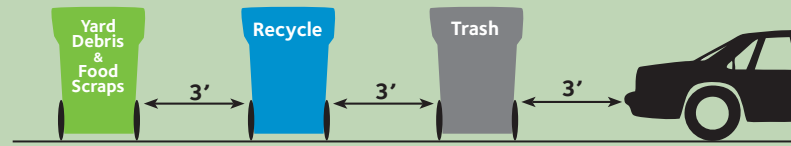


Service Information

CONTAINER SET OUT GUIDELINES



Please Allow Adequate Spacing Around Your Carts.

Your recycling cart will be collected every-other-week on your garbage collection day.

- Place carts at the curb by 6 a.m.
- Place carts three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward the street.
- Place carts at least three (3) feet from obstructions such as cars, trees, utility boxes, fences and mailboxes. Our trucks need clear access to empty carts.
- Place wheels as close to the curb as possible.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Waste Management provides collection service on all holidays except Thanksgiving, Christmas Day (Dec. 25) New Years Day (Jan. 1), Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day. If any of these holidays fall on or after your regular collection day, your scheduled collection will be one day later that week. For example, if a holiday falls on a Thursday, Thursday customers will be collected on Friday and Friday customers will be collected on Saturday. **If a holiday falls on a weekend, there is no service change.**

SERVICE DELAYS

Waste Management is able to provide service in most weather conditions.

If weather conditions prevent safe collection, up to twice as much garbage, recyclables and compostables will be collected at no extra charge on your next regular collection day. No credits will be issued for collection delays due to weather.

Hazardous products that say "Caution, Warning, Danger or Poison" on the label are harmful to humans, wildlife and the environment and are not allowed in the garbage.

RECYCLING

Empty and rinse containers out. Place loose in cart.



Clean paper and cardboard

- Newspaper
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Magazines and Catalogs
- Telephone Books
- Printer Paper
- Junk Mail
- Cereal and Pop Boxes
- Shoe Boxes
- Non-Coated Paper Products



Flatten and cut cardboard to fit into the cart with the lid shut

Clean, empty glass bottles and jars

Labels OK



Clean metal

- Aluminum Cans
- Tin, Steel and Metal Cans
- Aerosol cans (*empty, no lids or tips*)
- Small pieces of Scrap Metal (*not sharp or greasy*)



Clean plastic

Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs and Cups.



Recycling Tips

All recyclables should be placed in your Blue Cart.



There is no limit on recycling. Put extra recyclables in a clearly labeled kraft bag, cardboard box or 32-gallon container with handles and lid. Please label "Recycle."

- Plastic Bags
- Foam cups, blocks & packing materials
- Food-soiled items
- Microwave Trays
- Ceramics & Dishes
- Light Bulbs
- Window Glass & Mirrors
- Hazardous Waste Containers

YARD AND FOOD WASTE

Food scraps and leftovers

All these items be composted in your food and yard waste cart.



Food-soiled paper

- Paper towels
- Napkins
- Food-Soiled Paper Bags
- Greasy Pizza Boxes
- Shredded Paper
- Tea Bags, Coffee Grounds and Filters



Yard trimmings

- Leaves, Grass, Plant Trimmings
- Branches and Undecorated
- Christmas Trees (*must be cut into 4 foot lengths and fit in your cart*)



Extra Yard Trimmings

There is a charge for extra yard trimmings. Label cans or paper bags "Yard Waste" and put them next to your yard waste cart at least 3 feet from garbage. Extra carts are available for a fee.



Put extra yard trimmings in:

- Cans with handles, marked "yard waste" (32 gal., 65 lb. limit)
- Bundle extra branches (4x2x2 ft. limit)

KEEP OUT OF YARD AND FOOD WASTE

- Twine
- Plastic Bags & Containers
- Fats, Oil or Grease
- Glass
- Metal
- Foil
- Liquids
- Diapers & Pet Waste
- Garden Hoses

GARBAGE

These items are neither recyclable nor compostable. Please put them in your garbage cart.



Non-recyclable plastic

All these items go into your garbage cart.



Non-recyclable glass

- Window Panes, Mirrors
- Ceramics, Dishware, Broken Glass
- Standard Light Bulbs



Non-recyclable paper

- Non-Food Soiled Paper Towels
- Shiny, Coated or Foil Paper
- Hardcover Books (*donate to a charity or school*)



Non-recyclable metal

- Latex Paint Cans (*harden paint with kitty litter or paint hardener, then place in garbage*)
- Lids and Caps
- Sharp Metal
- Small Appliances (*donate to a charity if working*)



Garbage Tips and Guidelines

- Please bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet waste, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust, and cold ashes.



Garbage charges are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed. Bulky items like mattresses, appliances, and building materials can be picked up by special arrangement for a fee. Call Waste Management customer service at 1-877-466-4668 or visit wmnorthwest.com.

2017-18 Collection Schedule

PLEASE POST

Please place carts at the curb by 6 a.m.

- Three (3) feet apart with lids opening street-side
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible

Please remove carts from street as soon as possible after collection.

Please follow the collection schedule below:

Recycling is collected on blue weeks on garbage day.

Holiday Delays: If collection falls on or after Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Labor Day or 4th of July, collection will be one day later, including Saturday service for Friday customers.

Monthly winter yard waste will be collected the first full week December - February as indicated on the calendar.

Weekly yard waste will end on Dec 1, 2017 and resume February 26, 2018. Please follow the schedule below.

Christmas trees will be collected January 2-6, 2018. One (1) extra charge will be applied to non-yard waste subscribers per whole tree. Trees must be cut to sections no longer or wider than four (4) feet.
