

City of Spokane Valley Annual Curbside Cleanup Program

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the Annual Curbside Cleanup Program?

WM and the City of Spokane Valley have partnered to provide all single-family residents with the Annual Curbside Cleanup Program for bulky waste. All WM residential customers are eligible for one "no charge" collection per calendar year.

Q: Who Can Participate?

City of Spokane Valley single-family residents who subscribe to WM collection service and have an account in good standing.

Q: How do I participate?

<u>Email</u> or call seven days in advance to schedule collection: 877-466-4668. (No collection during holiday weeks.)

Q: How many pickups are allowed?

One bulky waste no charge collection per calendar year.

Q: Can I set out bags of garbage?

The Annual Curbside Cleanup Program is meant for items that are too bulky or large to put in your regular garbage cart, e.g. an old vacuum, broken big wheel, plastic swimming pool, mattress or chair.



Q: Is there a size limit?

Yes. Two (2) large items such as appliances or furniture and/or 1 cubic yard of household garbage (around 3' X 3' total) of small items weighing less than 65 lbs. We reserve the right to refuse items that are not listed, or items that are contaminated or too large/heavy to safely handle.

Q: What is acceptable household waste that I can set out for bulky collection?

Here is a list of items that you can leave out for a scheduled pickup:

- Stoves
- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners
- Drvers
- Water Heaters
- Passenger car or motorcycle tires <u>limit 2</u>
- Computers/TV's (flat screens)
- Lawn mowers
- Power Tools

- Washers
- Small Appliances
- Dishwashers
- Doors & Windows
- Toilets & sinks
- Mattresses
- Non-reusable household junk

All oil and fuel must be drained prior

Q: Are there items that are prohibited in the Annual Curbside Cleanup?

Yes. Please avoid leaving any of these items for pickup. Scheduled pickups containing these items will be rejected.
