Plastic bags Bag plastic bags together and bring them to your local grocery store for recycling.



Hardcover books Donate them to a school or charity.



Shredded paper Layer in your compost cart or use to soak up and harden latex paint.



Latex paint cans may be placed in the

garbage if paint is solidified. To solidify, mix in cat litter, shredded paper, sawdust, or paint hardener. Once paint is dry, leave the lid off the can, bag it and place in your garbage!

• Bag all garbage.

Other garbage

• Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing peanuts, vacuum dust, sawdust and cold ashes.

Extra Garbage

Garbage charges are based on cart size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid closed. If your garbage cart lid is open more than 6 inches, there will be a charge for extra garbage.

Bulky items such as mattresses, large appliances and building materials can be picked up by special arrangement for a fee. Contact us for fee information.
