Compost Days - The Big Garden Give– Coming to Snohomish County!

Compost Days is a region-wide campaign to thank residents for composting at the curb and diverting 350,000 tons of food, food-soiled paper and yard debris from landfills in 2014.

To celebrate, from March 15 – April 15, residents can cash in on deep discounts on Cedar Grove compost and 25% off kitchen containers and compostable bags at area Fred Meyer stores.

Big Garden Give – Compost Drive

For the second year in a row, the Compost Days “Big Garden Give” compost drive will contribute free compost to schools and gardens that grow food for low-income residents. For every bag of Cedar Grove compost purchased during Compost Days, one bag of compost will be donated to school-based garden programs and community gardens.

Last year, through Compost Days, residents donated 1,119 yards of compost, enough to fill nearly 450 standard pick-up truck beds. Let’s spread even more compost good cheer this year!
