## RECYCLING

Recycling collection is available in select areas. All of these materials are accepted in your recycle cart.

## YARD DEBRIS

Yard debris is available by subscription in select areas. All of these materials are accepted in your yard debris cart.

### PLANTS, FLOWERS AND YARD TRIMMINGS

Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, vegetative garden waste, windfall fruit, grass clippings and brush.



#### KEEP OUT OF YARD DEBRIS:

Dirt • Rocks • Pet Waste • Hoses • Plastic Bags • Tarps  
Food Scraps • Liquids • Fats • Oils • Grease

### EXTRA YARD DEBRIS

You can set out extra yard debris on collection day for a charge. Set out extras in a kraft paper bag, 32 gallon personal can (limit 55 lbs) or bundle tied with biodegradable twine (4'x2' limit). Yard debris collection is available by subscription in designated areas.

### APPLE MAGGOT QUARANTINE

If you live in the Apple Maggot Quarantine Zone of Chelan County, which includes the Leavenworth, Plain, and Lake Wenatchee area, your yard debris must stay in the quarantine area. For more information visit: <https://agr.wa.gov/departments/insects-pests-and-weeds/insects/apple-maggot>



**Please place containers at the curb  
by 6 am Oct 1- May 31 and by 5 am  
June 1-Sept 30.**

- Place containers three (3) feet apart with lids opening towards street.
- Place containers at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, and mailboxes.
- Please take containers in as soon as possible after collection.
