### Extra **Yard Waste**

If you often generate extra yard waste, additional carts are offered at a discount rate for those with large yards or seasonal volume needs.

For occasional extra vard waste, place next to yard+food waste cart in any of the following:

- Heavy brown paper yard bags (available at hardware stores)
- 32-gallon cans labeled "Yard Waste" (65 lb. limit)
- Bundles tied with natural twine (4'x2' limit)
