RECYCLING LIST

Place loose, clean recyclables into your blue recycling bin.

RECYCLABLES SHOULD BE CLEAN, DRY, AND EMPTY.

Paper and Cardboard

Mail, envelopes, newspaper, flattened cardboard, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper boxes (cereal, etc.) Cardboard must be broken down and bundled into 3'x3' pieces



Plastic Bottles and Jugs

Plastic bottles (clean, empty a and no lids)

Metal Cans

Aluminum & tin cans (no sharp or greasy metal)





When in doubt, throw it out.

ONLY listed items should go in your recycle bin.

No Motor Oil!

No Plastic Bags!

No Glass!







RECYCLING TIPS

- Put extra recyclables in a clearly labeled kraft paper bag, cardboard box or 32-gallon container with handles and lid. Please label "Recycle."
- If you have an old "glass only" labeled recycle bin, use it for mixed recycling.
- Motor oil and cooking oil can be recycled at the Transfer Station.
