Have glass to recycle? **Do not place** it in your recycling cart. Take it to one of the Residential Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste drop off locations listed. These transfer station facilities accept recycling (including glass) and household hazardous waste at no extra cost.

Extra Recycling:

Place extra recyclables in a bin or cardboard box at the curb next to your recyclling cart. There is a charge for extra recycling.



KEEP OUT of Your Recycling*

- A NO plastic bags
- A NO foam cups & packaging
- A NO hazardous waste
- A NO medical waste
- ▲ NO syringes
- NO batteries

- A NO diapers
- A NO liquids
- A NO fuel tanks
- A NO computers + tvs
- A NO shredded paper
- A NO aluminum foil
- A NO plastic berry containers
- NO broken dishes, glass, ceramics or window glass
- A NO paper cups and milk cartons
