Glass Bottles & Containers

Have glass to recycle? **Do not place it in your recycling cart.** Take it to one of the *Residential Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste drop off locations listed*. These transfer station facilities accept recycling (including glass) and household hazardous waste at no extra cost.

Extra Recycling:

Place extra recyclables in a bin or cardboard box at the curb next to your recycling cart. There is a charge for extra recycling.



KEEP OUT of Your Recycling*

- ✘ NO plastic bags
- ✘ NO foam cups & packaging
- ✘ NO hazardous waste
- ✘ NO medical waste
- ✘ NO syringes
- ✘ NO batteries
- ✘ NO diapers
- ✘ NO liquids
- ✘ NO fuel tanks
- ✘ NO computers + tvs
- ✘ NO shredded paper
- ✘ NO aluminum foil
- ✘ NO plastic berry containers
- ✘ NO broken dishes, glass, ceramics or window glass
- ✘ NO paper cups and milk cartons

*Contamination charges may be applied if your recycling cart contains non-recyclable items.
