COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these collection guidelines.

Please place containers at the curb by 7 am

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible
- Remove carts as soon as possible after collection



GARBAGE

There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid closed.

- · Weight limit 35-gallon cart, 65-pounds for your collector's safety.
- Bag garbage. Shopping bags works well.
- · Double bag pet litter, packing pellets, cold ashes and any dusty material.

▲ HAZARDOUS WASTE

Items such as fluorescent hulbs and tubes, loose needles, fuel tanks, computers and TVs are not allowed in garbage or recycling.
