

# RECYCLING

Please do not bag. Place these items loose in your recycling cart. Recyclables should be empty, clean & loose.



**Plastic Bottles & Containers**



**Clean Metal**



**Paper**



**Flattened Cardboard  
& Paperboard**



**Glass Bottles & Jars**



**Motor Oil & Cooking Oil**

Seal uncontaminated oil in clear, screw top plastic jugs. Label jugs with name + address. Place next to recycling cart. **Limit:** 3 gallons per pickup, 10 gallons per year. Single family residents only.

## **Extra Recycling**

Place extra recyclables in a bin or cardboard box at the curb next to your recycling cart. There is no charge for extra recycling.
