Extra Recycling

There is no charge for extra recycling.

Extra recyclables can be placed in 32-gallon containers with handles and lids, or in dry cardboard boxes or paper bags clearly labeled "Recycle".

If you frequently have excess recyclables, you can request a larger cart at no additional cost. Alternatively, you can order a second recycling cart for a nominal fee by contacting our customer service team.
