



# YARD DEBRIS

All of these items can go in your yard cart.

## Apple Maggot Quarantine:

Kittitas County is under an apple maggot quarantine. Waste from your yard, garden or agricultural property cannot leave the county. It is not allowed in garbage or recycling curbside carts. Please compost it on your own property, take it to a Kittitas County transfer station or subscribe to yard debris collection service.



### Yard Trimmings

- Leaves, Grass, Plant Trimmings, Fruit Fallen Waste and Garden Leftovers
- Branches and Christmas Trees (must be undecorated, unflocked, cut into 4 foot lengths and fit in your cart)



### KEEP OUT of Your Yard Debris

- ✘ Plastic Bags
- ✘ Glass
- ✘ Diapers
- ✘ Pet Waste
- ✘ Tarps

- ✘ Hoses
- ✘ Liquids
- ✘ Fats, Oils or Grease
- ✘ Dirt or Rocks
- ✘ Sod

### Extra Yard Waste:

There is a charge for extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

Put extra yard waste only in:

- Cans with handles (35 gal., 70 lb. limit)
- Label cans "Yard"
- Bundle tied with twine (4'x4' limit)
- Paper leaf bags
