### WHAT IS ACCEPTED: ALL-IN-ONE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Blueprints

Cardboard (flattened)

Carbonless forms

Copy paper

Ream wrappers

Manila file folders

Magazines, brochures

Envelopes (windows OK)

Phone books

Paperbacks, catalogs

Shredded paper (ONLY in securely tied clear plastic bag)











#### PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS

Paper cups

Milk & juice cartons Frozen food baxes

#### **CLEAN GLASS**

Bottles & jars (All colors, no lids)

#### CLEAN METAL

Aluminum & tin cans Scrap metal (Limit 2x2x2 ft, 35 lbs)

### CLEAN PLASTIC

Plastic bottles, jugs, jars, cups, dairy tubs (No lids, Styrofoam or plastic bags) Plastic film

(Only in securely tied clear plastic bag)
