Paper and Flattened Cardboard



Paper Cups and Cartons



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Cups and Tubs



Glass Bottles and Jars



Metal Cans



Your service includes a recycling container up to twice the volume of your garbage container at no additional charge.

1 yard



Included recycling service level:
2 yards
