Yard and Food Scrap Tips:

- In your kitchen, gather food scraps in a colander or strainer, reusable container with a lid or a paper bag
- Empty into your outdoor yard/food cart frequently.
- Layer food scraps with yard waste or newspaper to absorb liquids.

Extra Yard Waste:

There is a charge for extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

Put extra yard waste only in:

- Cans with handles (32 gal., 65 lb. limit)
- · Label cans "Yard"
- Bundle tied with twine (4'x2' limit)
- Paper leaf bags

GARBAGE

Charges are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid completely closed.

- Weight limit 32-gal/65 lbs for your collector's safety
- Bag garbage. Shopping bags work well!
- · Double bag pet litter, packing pellets and cold ashes
