- Keep recyclables out of bags and boxes.

#### Garbage Guidelines

• Please bag all garbage. Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust, and cold ashes.

#### **Extra Garbage:**

Garbage charges are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed. Bulky items like mattresses, appliances, and building materials can be picked up by special arrangement for a fee. Call WM customer service at 1-800-592-9995 to schedule collection.

#### Yard Trimmings

#### **KEEP OUT of Compostables**

- A Plastic Bags or Containers
- A Compostable Serviceware
  - Glass or Metal

- 🛕 Liquids
- A Fat, Oil or Grease
- Diapers or Pet Waste
- In your kitchen, gather food scraps in a container, paper bag or approved compostable bag (NO plastic bags)
- Empty into your outdoor compost cart when full.
- Layer food scraps with yard waste or newspaper to absorb liquids.

Put extra yard waste only in:

- Cans with handles (35 gal., 70 lb. limit)
- Label cans "Yard" • Bundle tied with twine (4'x2' limit)
- Paper leaf bags
