EXTRA RECYCLING

You can set out extra recycling on collection day for a charge. Set out extras in a 32-gallon personal can labeled 'Recycle' or cardboard boxes (limit 2'x2'x2').

YARD & FOOD WASTE

All of these materials can go in your green yard & food waste cart

FOOD SCRAPS AND LEFTOVERS

Meat, fish, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers.



FOOD-SOILED PAPER

Coffee grounds and filters, soiled paper bags, kitchen paper towels, paper napkins, pizza boxes. No Plastic lined paper products.



No plastic products – even those labeled "compostable"


PLANTS, FLOWERS AND YARD TRIMMINGS

Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, vegetative garden waste, windfall fruit, jack-o-lanterns and brush, branches less than 4 inches thick and 4 feet long, sod (no more than 60 lbs.)



EXTRA YARD WASTE

You can set out extra yard waste on collection day for a charge. Set out extras in a kraft paper bag, 32-gallon personal can (limit 65 lbs) or bundle tied with twine (4'x2' limit). Yard waste collection is available by subscription in designated areas. For more information or to sign up, please call 1-800-592-9995.



Please place containers at the curb by 6:00 a.m.

- Place containers two (2) feet apart with lids opening towards street.
- Place containers at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, and mailboxes.
- Please take containers in as soon as possible after collection.
