What can I bring?

Drop off old or unused household chemicals. Look for CAUTION, POISON, WARNING, DANGER, CAUSTIC, COMBUSTIBLE, FLAMMABLE or CORROSIVE on the label, or for chemical symbols. Common products:



- Aerosol cans
- Antifreeze
- Automotive fluids
- Batteries
- Bleach
- Drain cleaner
- Fluorescent bulbs/tubes*
- Gasoline/diesel
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Oil-based paint, varnish and stain
- Paint thinner
- Propane tanks
