

Don't bag recycling—place loose in your cart

Plastic Bottles

Screw lids back on empty plastic bottles.





Recycle plastics by shape only bottles, jugs, tubs and cups can be recycled.

Throw away all other plastic even if it has a "recycle symbol!"

Plastic Tubs + Cups

Throw out snap-on lids.

Metal Cans + Scrap Metal

Material must be at least 3 inches wide but no larger than 2'x2' and less than 35lbs. No sharp or greasy parts. No wood, plastic or rubber (pot handles OK).

Glass Bottles + Jars













Metal Lids



Metal lids that are 3 inches wide or larger can be recycled loose. Throw away smaller metal lids and caps.

- Motor oil in a transparent, 1-gallon jug with name and address (limit 2 gallons/week)
- Clothing and linens in a secure plastic bag labeled "textiles"
