



RECYCLING

Don't bag recycling—place loose in your cart

Plastic Bottles

Screw lids back on empty plastic bottles.

Recycle plastics by shape — only **bottles, jugs, tubs and cups** can be recycled.

Throw away all other plastic — even if it has a “recycle symbol!”

Plastic Tubs + Cups

Throw out snap-on lids.



Plastic Jugs

Paper + Cardboard

Metal Cans + Scrap Metal

Material must be at least 3 inches wide but no larger than 2'x2' and less than 35lbs. No sharp or greasy parts. No wood, plastic or rubber (pot handles OK).

Glass Bottles + Jars



Metal Lids



Metal lids that are 3 inches wide or larger can be recycled loose. Throw away smaller metal lids and caps.

Recycle at the Curb



Call to schedule free pick-up and place next to your cart on collection day: 1-800-592-9995

- **Motor oil** in a transparent, 1-gallon jug with name and address (limit 2 gallons/week)
- **Clothing and linens** in a secure plastic bag labeled “textiles”
